	<p>Daffodil: Sir Winston Churchill 10/bag</p> <p>Usually bears 3-5 silver dollar sized creamy white flowers with orange flecks per stem; great perennializer. 15-17" tall; 14-16 cm bulbs; plant 4-5/sq ft; late-mid spring. Excellent picked flower. Resembles a gardenia. A favorite of Neil Sperry's.</p>	
	<p>Daffodil: Carlton 12/bag</p> <p>The world's 2nd most numerous daffodil; one of best perennializers, especially in the South; two-tone yellow, with vanilla-like fragrance; 14-16" tall; 14-16 cm bulbs; plant 7-8/sq ft; blooms early spring.</p>	
	<p>Daffodil: Minnow 18/bag</p> <p>Fabulous miniature daffodil with white or yellow petals and tiny buttercup-yellow cups. 3-5 fragrant flowers per stem. Very strong performer., 5"-6" tall; 12+cm bulbs; Blooms mid spring.</p>	
	<p>Tulip: Little Beauty 18/ bag</p> <p>Reddish pink petals with a bluish heart; super strong, really showy, but delicate looking flower with great colors! 4-6" tall; 6-8 cm bulbs; Blooms mid-spring.</p>	
	<p>Tulip: Peppermint Stick 12 /bag</p> <p>The true red and white tulip named after the candy cane; light, bright, small flower, with purple heart. 6-8" tall; 6-8 cm. bulbs; Blooms mid-late spring.</p>	
	<p>Hyacinthus: Royal Navy 7/bag</p> <p>Deep color with <u>double florets</u>; many florets make one large, long-lasting bloom; rigid, upright; 8"-10" tall; 15-16 cm. bloom; Plant 5/sq. ft. Blooms mid-spring. A favorite of Dallas Arboretum.</p>	
	<p>Leucojum: aestivum 'Gravetye Giant' 7/bag</p> <p>Pendulous white bells with green tips; Looks like a giant 'Lily-of-the-Valley'; 18-24" tall; plant 5-6/sq.ft. Blooms mid-late spring.</p>
